

In their last annual report the Commissioners referred at length to the arguments which had been advanced by certain magazine writers, and others in the United States with a view to influencing public sentiment against the use of Niagara River water for the generation of electrical power. The immediate cause of the protest was an application made by a Power Company, on the American side to take from the river, above the located works of the...
